Wills & Trusts

A Will is essential to ensure your estate passes to your intended beneficiaries and can avoid costly disputes. It should be reviewed every 2 years at least.

Lasting Powers of Attorney (LPA)

These legal documents allow you to appoint the people you trust to manage your finances and make health and welfare decisions if you are no longer able to do so.

Inheritance Tax and Estate Planning

Inheritance Tax is one of the most preventable taxes and good planning (often incorporating the use of Trusts) can help minimise your liability.

‘Estate Planning’ refers to the varied financial and legal options available to plan in a tax-efficient manner.

Probate

Probate is the administration of the estate of someone who has died and we can guide you through this complex process.

Contentious Probate
